Ivory finalising master plan for submission

GEORGE TOWN: Property developer Ivory Properties Group Berhad (IPGB), who won the bid for the purchase of 41.5ha land in Bayan Mutiara, is finalising the master plan before its submission to the Town and Country Planning Department (JPBD) and Penang Municipal Council (MPPP).

IPGB deputy chairman and executive director Datuk Seri Nazir Ariff said the company shall comply with the necessary requirements in accordance to the guidelines of MPPP.

“Community facilities for public purposes such as legal access, bicycle tracks, infrastructures, low-medium cost housing, schools, mosque and place of religious worship for non-Muslims will be provided accordingly should the need arises.

“In our master plan, we also strive to achieve the Penang state’s vision for a ‘Cleaner, Greener Penang’,” he said in a statement.

Referring to a letter from Nazir to Penang Chief Minister Lim Guan Eng on Nov 18, 2011, the former said IPGB had acknowledged the Penang state government and Chief Minister’s vision to strive and provide schools, mosque and place of religious worship for non-Muslims at other suitable location.

“We have given our commitment to work with the Penang state government and Chief Minister to realise the vision,” he said.
