### **Developer: Stop the squabble and let us deliver**

GEORGE TOWN: A property developer has urged all parties to stop the squabble over hillslope development and let the developers deliver their work on time.

Ivory Properties Group Berhad deputy chairman and executive director Datuk Seri Nazir Ariff said any further delay would only jeopardise the delivery time of the completed houses to purchasers.

“Our immediate priority now is to complete The Peak Residences project, which has been implicated in the on-going issue, on time and hand the keys to purchasers by end of 2013.

“This is an abandoned project in 1996 affecting 588 purchasers and they have waited long enough. We really pity them and we cannot afford to have any further delay.

“Those who have been making noise on the development have nothing to lose out but the real loss lies on the purchasers. We just want to play our role to deliver,” he said in a press statement yesterday (July 10).

Nazir said several buyers have since been calling them up at the office to voice their concern on the project development.

“The buyers, mostly from the affected group, were asking if our project will be abandoned again as they are really worried-stricken.

“We are merely acting as white knight in response to calls from the state government to save the project and we hope to gain the support from all parties concerned,” he said.

Nazir said the project was a tough one given the many constraints and rocks to remove.

“That was when we finally understand that the difficulty could be one of the reasons for the project to be abandoned.

“Nevertheless, we will still try our best to meet the deadline and deliver quality houses to all purchasers,” he said.
